I then called Sidek Embong for some information but unfortunately he wasn't even aware that Dennis had passed.

After that I called Raju Suppiah also from the same batch. Raju remembers Dennis quite well. He informed me that Dennis had a furniture shop in Kuala Trengganu.

Dennis was a Woodwork Optionist and he stayed back another year after the two years in Kirkby to do an advanced course in woodwork. He must have been very good in this field.

Satish tells me that he met Dennis in Kuala Trengganu when Satish was in the Inspectorate in those days. Dennis was teaching woodwork in Sultan Sulaiman Secondary School.

Dennis' wife passed away four years ago.

Dennis went to the hospital for his check up on Monday accompanied by his sister-in-law. While at the hospital he had a massive heart attack, collapsed and died.
